GUESTS WHO ARE JR HIGH AGE (OR) YOUNGER (OR) OVER THE AGE OF TWENTY WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO ATTEND MAINE WEST SCHOOL EVENTS, INCLUDING PROM.
